



- Maryland residents can register and vote on the same day.
- Maryland joined 15 other states and the District of Columbia
- Residents have been able to register, or change their address, and cast a ballot the same day during early voting since 2016. But in 2018, voters <u>approved a</u>
 <u>constitutional amendment</u> to allow people to sign up and cast ballots on Election Day itself.
- Residents must bring a document proving their residency. Eligible documents include a Maryland driver's license, paycheck, bank statement, utility bill or other government document with individual's name and current address.



SAME DAY VOTER REGISTRATION DURING EARLY VOTING & ELECTION DAY

SECTION 203 OF THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT: INFORM, ASSIST & ENFORCE

When Congress amended the Voting Rights Act in 1975 by adding Section 203, it found that "through the use of various practices & procedures, citizens of language minorities have been effectively excluded from participation in the electoral process.

*Montgomery County's consent decree was established in 2002.



ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS & NATURALIZATION

In order to become a naturalized U.S. citizen, most applicants need to show that they can speak, read, and write in English. HOWEVER, if you are age 50 or older and have lived in the U.S. as a green card holder (permanent resident) for at least 20 years, you can have the citizenship interview conducted in your native language. Individuals age 55 or older (at the time of naturalization filing), with a valid green card, and have lived in the U.S. for 15 years, can also leverage the following exemption.

*Commonly referred to as the "50/20 or 55/15" exception as per the U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services & Department of Homeland Security



Voting after a Criminal Conviction

You can vote even if you were convicted of a felony, if:

*The felony convictions are not for the crime of buying or selling votes; and;

*You have completed your imprisonment.

*You can vote while on probation, unless you were convicted of buying or selling votes.

Must be received by October 20...


In addition to the 11 Early Voting Centers, 248 polling places will be consolidated into vote centers

- MCPS high schools will be used, except Thomas Edison HS
- White Oak Senior & Community Recreation Center
- Nancy H. Dacek North Potomac Community Recreation Center
- Marriott Hotel & Montgomery County Conference Center
- Each vote center will have a ballot drop box
- LIKE EARLY VOTING, VOTER NOT TIED TO NEIGHBORHOOD VOTE CTR



Voting twice is illegal and you shouldn't do it!

You will need to vote a Provisional ballot if you change your mind after requesting a Mail-in ballot.





Ballot Marking Devices available during Early voting & Election Day vote centers. It produces a paper record for tabulation. As a marker, the ExpressVote handles the entire marking process, eliminating unclear marks.





Election officials & voter can configure the ExpressVote to their voting needs.

Multiple options:

- * Use sip & puff equipment
- * English or Spanish audio/text
- * High or low contrast
- * Grey scale
- * Magnified ballot
- * Braille keypad
